## **TOYS FOR TOTS**

Premier Eye Care will once again be collecting for the Marine Corps Toys for Tots. Toys for Tots is a program run by the United States Marine Corps Reserve that distributes toys to children whose parents cannot afford to buy them gifts for Christmas. The program founded by Reservist Major Bill Hendricks in 1947 is a 501(c) not-for-profit public charity. The mission of the program "is to collect new, unwrapped toys during October, November and December each year, and distribute those toys as Christmas gifts to needy children in the community in which the campaign is conducted."

The stated goal is to "deliver, through a new toy at Christmas, a message of hope to less fortunate youngsters that will assist them in becoming responsible, productive, and patriotic citizens." As of 2016, the Toys for Tots and Foundation have collected and distributed more than 512 million toys.
