## RED NOSE DAY

Premier's fifth Red Nose Day was a great success. We collected \$615, which became \$1,845 with Premier's generous 2x match. Founded by Comic Relief, Inc., Red Nose Day is dedicated to raising money to help children who are most in need in the poorest communities in the world. Every dollar raised chips away at poverty. Thank you to Liz Colon for spearheading this event and collecting money so diligently. Thank you to Ron Pierre for photographing this worthy cause, and thank you to all who donated!

In just four years, almost \$150 million has been raised, which means:

- **13.5M** essential medical services to underserved children
- **40M** vaccinations administered
- **36M** meals served to children
- **76K** homeless teens given shelter
- **1.2M** children accessing extracurricular activities and sports that break the cycle of poverty, exclusion and violence



## THE PANTRY OF BROWARD


