Abandoned Pet Rescue (APR), founded in 1996, is a 501(C)(3) IRS tax-exempt, qualified non-profit charitable organization that rescues and shelters abandoned, abused, and neglected pets, rehabilitates them and finds them new homes. APR is one of the largest no kill animal shelters in South Florida and is devoted to the welfare of all animals. This charity is currently support more than 50 abandoned dogs and over 300 abandoned cats and kittens. Adoptions are available.

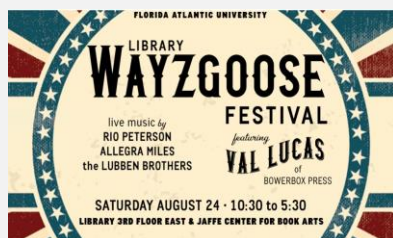
Collection receptacles are located in the lobby and Premier Café for your convenience.
