THANKSGIVING SAFETY TIPS...

Never handle cooked and raw food together, in order to avoid cross-contamination. Be mindful of children & pets around hot appliances and sharp tools. Use a thermometer on the innermost part of turkey to ensure it is well cooked. When serving, keep hot foods hot foods <a href="https://docs.pythology.cold/"

Consume leftovers within 3 days. After 3 days, leftovers should be frozen or thrown away. Store food in shallow containers. Cook reheated leftovers to 165 degrees F; Boil reheated gravy. Wash hands with soap and water and keep all surfaces and utensils clean. Happy, Safe Thanksgiving!
