Scope: An in-office diagnostic test performed during the eye exam to evaluate the internal drainage system of the eye, the anterior chamber angle. The angle is where the cornea and iris meet. By looking at the angle, the physician can determine if it is open or closed, if there are abnormal blood vessels, adhesions, or damage from eye trauma.
